(554) Barolo, Mauro Molino 98 <i>This wine exhibits a layered bouquet of licorice, rose petals, tar, and sweet plum juice in a medium body. Tannic, yet very approachable and food-friendly.</i>	15/60
Hermitage “Nobles Rives”, Tain l’Hermitage 99 <i>Hermitage is the noblest appellation in the Rhône. With enough bottle age on it, this medium-bodied wine is now starting to show all its character with an intense set of gamey and earthy aromas followed by mineral, plum, tar and smoke flavors. The finish is long and clean.</i>	49
Bandol, Jean-Pierre Gausson 98 <i>A big and rustic wine showing all the power of the local Mourvedre grape, full bodied and generous – as its inky color will suggest. It has serious earthy flavors and tannins that will linger.</i>	38

Pinot Blanc, La Bête 03, Oregon <i>Off the beaten path, Pinot Blanc has a character of its own, pleasant and interesting with aromas of flowers and lightly smoky minerals. To the palate it offers a medium body and gentle minerality and fruit, characterized by a slightly flinty line. It has a surprisingly long finish on apples.</i>	8/28
Sauvignon Blanc, Pojer & Sandri 02, Friuli <i>Between Loire and Marlborough: tropical fruits, fresh grass and intense minerality come together in a mouthwatering combination. Light-bodied.</i>	37
Chablis, Domaine d’Elise 00 <i>This Chardonnay has never seen wood, yet its age and time spent “on the lees” have given it a unique creaminess. Aromas and flavors of butter, cheese and ripe yellow apple are immediate while mineral and citrus notes sit in the background. I celledared it for two years in my private “cantina”: it is at peak now.</i>	36
